It is designed for families looking to involve multiple people in their grantmaking and distributing over \$100,000 per annum. The process is summarised in a Giving Roadmap, which includes your mission and/or legacy statement, giving preferences and suggested next steps.

MAD Workshop

Are you hoping to nurture the next generation's passion for giving back and get your children or grandchildren involved in your philanthropy? APS has developed an interactive **'Make A Difference (MAD) Workshop'** for school-aged children between the ages of 7-17. It gives them an opportunity to have their voices heard and provides them with ideas for getting involved in the community. The MAD workshop can be delivered stand-alone or integrated into the Giving Compass for the whole family.

Giving Gauge

Designed for foundations already embarked on their giving journey, usually within their first one to five years. This online survey and facilitated reflection session is an opportunity to take stock and consider what is working, and what needs to change, in your giving strategy and grantmaking processes.
